One who thinks he has saliva in his mouth and swallows, when in fact, he had קרבן חטאת a חייב.

One who intended to do one מלאכה yet committed another מלאכה, for example, he intended to throw a rock at an animal in order to kill it, yet the rock inadvertently hit a tree and uprooted it, he is פטור from bringing a איסור. One who intended to commit a lighter איסור, such as carrying an object four מחלית in a מכור is also פטור פטור.

One who transgressed many מלאכות in one state of forgetfullness, must bring a separate קרבן חטאת for every אב מלאכה, but if he did many of one אב he only brings one קרבן. For example, one who was קרבן and מרכיב (pruning, sowing and grafting) is only קרבן as these are all זורע, זומר.

One who prunes a tree and also needs the branches, transgresses two קרבנות and נוטע and must bring two קרבנות.

One who does an act of destruction is פטור from bringing a קרבן, for example, one who digs a pit only to gather the dirt, and he has no intent in making a hole, since to transgress the בונה of מלאכה would require a hole being dug for a constructive purpose.

Reaping, cutting, harvesting, collecting and gathering are all one מלאכה (קוצר).

The מעמר only applies to things that grow from the ground (for example, it is forbidden to gather salt from salt mines, but this is considered an איסור דרבנן as salt does not come from the ground).
