One is liable if he takes out enough forty day old urine, or any other agent that can be used as a detergent, to wash the small garment that goes on the top of a woman's hat. Pepper, one is liable even for a very small amount (this was a pepper carried in one's mouth to fight bad breath). Something that gives off a bad smell (which fights off ממיקין) even a small amount.

One who states: "I take upon myself to bring iron to the בית הקדש", he must give something that has value, therefore, it must be minimally one by one אמה of iron.

One who brings out a peddler spice box, although it contains many types of spices, he is nonetheless חטאת one חייב.

One is liable if he takes out seeds (for planting) less than the size of a גרוגרת. One is liable for a locust of any size. For taking out pits: if for eating, five. For fire, the amount needed to cook a small egg. For accounting or planting, two.

One is liable for removing two hairs from a horses or cows tail (which are used in the making of nets).

## erd of פרק רבי עקיבא

Notwithstanding all the aforementioned amounts, if one stored away seeds, or medicine, or something (for example, a piece of cloth) to be put away to be shown to a prospective buyer, he is חייב even on a small amount. The amounts given previously, are that for which an average person is חייב, but a person who stores these things away, even at such a small size, thus gives them חשיבות and he is קרבן a חייב even for a מהשהוא.
