An animal may be used as a wall for a סוכה, provided that the animal is tied down (so that it will not wander off).

A בת ישראל who is married to a בחומה may eat תרומה even if her husband is overseas, as he is בחוקת חיים. However, if he is in a city that has been captured, or a ship that was lost at sea, she may not eat תרומה, as he is very possibly not alive. While such a woman may eat תרומה until she is divorced, if a husband gave his wife a conditional גט that only takes effect an hour before the husband dies, she may no longer eat תרומה.
